

All berry crops harvested in Oregon in 1998 had total utilized production of 171.3 million pounds, 3 percent less than in 1997, but 17 percent more than in 1996. Total value of all berry crops in 1998 was \$89.5 million, down slightly from \$90.2 million in 1997. All caneberry production was down 12 percent from 1997, while total value decreased 9 percent. Compared with the 1996 crop, caneberry production was up 23 percent and value was down 30 percent. The all caneberry price decreased from \$0.921 in 1996 to \$0.520 per pound in 1998. The Oregon Raspberry and Blackberry Commission contributed funding for this report.
