\*\* Weight of purchased berries - The actual weight of berries for which payment is made ORS Chapter 576.335 (2) "A person responsible for collecting an assessment for a commission who fails to deduct an assessment at the time of sale shall report and pay the assessment to the commission. A producer required to report and pay an assessment is subject to this section." ORS Chapter 576.355 (1) "In addition to the penalties prescribed in ORS 576.991, any person who delays transmittal of funds beyond the time set by the commission shall pay 10 % of the amount due and shall also pay 1 ½ % interest per month on the unpaid balance of the assessment.
